Mata Tripura Sundari Open University (MTSOU) has received approval from the University Grants Commission (UGC) to offer various programmes through open and distance learning (ODL). The university has started admissions for the 2025-26 academic session, offering 27 ODL programmes. The approval covers Certificate, Diploma, PG Diploma, Undergraduate, and Postgraduate programmes. Admissions began in August/September 2025 for courses in Humanities, Social Sciences, Management, and Computer Science. The courses are Skill-based and employment oriented, aligning with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. Students in Tripura can also pursue dual degree programmes, taking MTSOU's distance/online degree alongside regular courses.

MTSOU and UPRTOU Sign MoU


